

Help bring a park to downtown Blairsville!

The long-vacant G. C. Murphy Building, located in downtown Blairsville had fallen into such a severe state of disrepair, it became necessary for the building to be demolished in June, 2020. Left behind was a sizable empty lot on the corner of Market and South Stewart Streets in the heart of the town's business district. The "Murphy Lot" is owned by Blairsville Community Development Authority (BCDA).

In August 2020, the BCDA and the Indiana County Office of Planning & Development partnered on The Murphy Lot Visioning Project, an engagement process that gathered community input to develop a plan for the Murphy Lot location. Through the initial visioning project, community members participated in a series of meetings and surveys, and shared their ideas on how the Murphy Lot could add the most value to the Blairsville and Indiana County communities. Upon conclusion of a series of public meetings, a core group of volunteers has stayed committed to the project. The project team is working closely with the BCDA and Blairsville Borough to convert the lot to a public space where generations of community members can come together and enjoy downtown Blairsville. The team has established detailed plans for development of a park; the central focal point, a fountain surrounded by benches. The park will incorporate native plantings, trees, and seating areas which will be inviting for both residents and visitors to downtown businesses.

The BCDA have agreed that once the park has been developed, the property will be deeded to the Borough of Blairsville to be maintained as a park. The Murphy Lot has been designated a Park in Perpetuity under the Donated or Dedicated Property Act under the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania laws. This assures that the park will be here to stay, and we can look forward to enjoying the park for many years to come! We are also excited to see the progress on the park development, which started in April 2024! Our aim is to have the grand opening of the park in Spring 2025 (Blairsville's Bicentennial year)!

While we appreciate the funds that we have received so far, we are still seeking donations to complete and maintain the park. This informational packet provides an overview of park elements that can be sponsored as well as other contribution options. How you can Contribute

Park Amenity Contributions

Each amenity (excluding bricks) includes a dedication plaque, if desired.

Engraved Brick Paver

\$150

Honor your family and loved ones with a custom-engraved 4x8-inch brick, which will be nestled into the walkway of the park. Up to 3 lines of text, 18 characters per line (including letters and spaces).

Engraved Square Brick Paver

\$300

Honor your family and loved ones with a large custom-engraved 8x8-inch brick, which will be nestled into the walkway of the park. Up to 6 lines of text, 18 characters per line (including letters and spaces).

Garden \$5,000

One garden will run along the length of the park, near the adjoining building. Another will be around the central fountain area. To be planted with native varieties of perennial plants under the guidance of a local master gardener.

Tree \$700

Create a living dedication with a tree, which will grow for years to come and create beautiful scenery to enjoy throughout the seasons.

Four-foot Bench SOLD OUT!

A beautiful classic bench that has stood the test of time. Originally developed for the World's Fair in 1939, this bench emphasizes circular patterns in the park and provides a comfortable place to sit. Will surround the fountain.

Six-foot Bench SOLD OUT!

A slightly longer version of the four-foot bench. These benches will dot the walkways of the park. Made of iron and ipe wood, a wood that has the strength of steel and is weather-resistant.

Outdoor Table & Seating SOLD OUT!

Durable & weather-resistant 3-foot round concrete table & bench set to be placed near front of the park. Made in Pennsylvania.

Large Outdoor Table & Seating SOLD OUT!

Durable & weather-resistant 5-foot round concrete table & bench set to be placed under the pergolas.

Pergola <u>SPONSORED</u>

Two pergolas will stand at the southern end of the park.

Fountain SPONSORED

Fountain at the center of the park.
